YEAR 6 SATS RESULTS

I have been informed by DfE that this year's SATS results have been delayed by just over a week.

*Schools were due to receive their results on **7 July 2026**. However, results will now be available on **16 July 2026**. Pearson Education Limited, the contractor responsible for the end-to-end administration of the Key Stage 2 tests, has informed us that additional time is needed to ensure the online results portal is ready for schools to access results. The delay relates to the readiness of the system used to make results available to schools.*

This means that, unfortunately, the Year 6 end of year reports will not be coming to parents until the last few day's of term. We can only apologise for this but as I am sure you will appreciate, this is something beyond our control.

All other year group reports should be with you by Tuesday 14th July.
