Dear Parents/Carers,

OFSTED

As you will be aware we were visited by Ofsted inspectors on Tuesday and Wednesday this week. The inspection framework is very rigorous and has changed since the last inspection we had in December 2021.

Seven areas of the school were assessed: EYFS, curriculum and teaching, attendance and behaviour, inclusion, leadership and governance, inclusion and finally personal development and wellbeing. We had to provide lots of evidence for each area and had interviews with the inspectors to further justify our self-evaluation judgement. Can I take this opportunity to thank all of you who completed the *parent questionnaire* as part of the process too. Your comments, I am told, were very supportive of what we do here.

Unfortunately, our draft report won't be ready to publish, possibly until September, as it has to go through quality assurance, drafting and then final release which could take longer than the time we have left this term. Needless to say, once it is published the document will be shared with you. Thank you, as always for your support.

SPORTS TOPS

Please can I remind parents to return the school's sports tops at their earliest convenience so we can kit our children out in them when they represent the school. I am a number of the red and black tops still missing so if you could please have a look for them that would be appreciated. Thank you.

LATE ARRIVALS

Please can we ask parents to remind their children to come into school via the main entrance if they are arriving after the gate has closed at 8.55am. This is so they can be added to the register by the admin team; also classroom doors may not always be open.

SPORTS AFTERNOONS

On Tuesday 7th July, we will be hosting our KS1 and Year 3 Sports afternoon and on Thursday 9th July we will be hosting our Year 4 – Year 6 Sports afternoon, both once again kindly being organised by Mrs Bennett.

You will have received a letter stating what colour top your child needs to wear for the event. This is because every child is placed in one of four teams: red, blue, green or purple. Please do not go and buy a top especially for this – we can provide bibs or coloured bands for your child if required. I am asking that KS1 and Y3 children come to school in PE kit on that Tuesday and Y4-Y6 children come in PE kit on the Thursday.

The gates will be opened at 1.15pm once lunchtime has finished for parents to congregate on the school field. The events are scheduled to start at 1.30pm. We look forward to seeing you then.

Arbor MIS

Arbor App and notifications. Guardians will be notified about new in-app messages received. Push notifications will be sent to those guardians who installed the mobile app and enabled push notifications. For those who do not have the mobile app installed, or have not enabled push notifications, an email will be sent instead.

A few parents have mentioned they are not receiving *Arbor App notifications*. There is guidance on the school website regarding enabling these. It may be after a phone update it has toggled this permission for notification off, please go to your settings. You can also switch the notifications off, then switch your phone off, restart and then switch notifications on. At a last resort, the app may need to be uninstalled and reinstalled.

Password resets: this can easily be done by the office please let us know if you need this doing. The app will ask for you to change your password after a period of time for security reasons.

Shared email address: if you share a family email address, this can cause issues with the App. When you log in, you are essentially removing your partner from their access to App. We can easily amend one of your email addresses so this doesn't happen.
